Internet Basics

Origins of the Internet

- Advanced Research Projects Agency (ARPA) of the U.S. government created the Internet in 1969
 - Un-interruptible communications network
- Government
- Military
- Research

Internet Basics

Benefits of the Internet

- It was a worldwide system of computer networks - a network of networks
- It allowed research scientists to "talk to" each other at distant universities, military installations, etc.
- All text-based information
 - HTLML

Internet Basics

The Key Benefit

- Messages could be routed or rerouted
- · In more than one direction
- Network could/would continue to function even if parts of it were destroyed* in the event of a military attack or other disaster.
 - *It worked on September 11th when cell phones couldn't...

What is the Internet today?

- a worldwide network of networks open to the public that is used for:
 - Communication
 - Research
 - Education
 - Commerce
 - Military/government business
 - Entertainment and socializing
 - everything...

Internet Basics

What changed?

- · Creation of the WWW
 - Tim Berners-Lee 1989
- Development of a Graphic User Interface (GUI) A "Browser"
 - MIT Mosaic 1993
- WWW part of the Internet became accessible to the public (Web 1.0)
- Read/write web = Web 2.0

Internet Basics

What Is A Browser

- · A translator of programming language
- A graphical interface for the code
 - A window to the Internet
- A way to access search tools
- A tool for bookmarking favorite sites
- A tool for collecting images for later use

- Search Engine
 - -Spiders and robots "bots"
 - -new findings logged automatically
 - -Some sites are submitted by "owner"
 - -unique mathematical equation
 - "algorithm" used in searches
 - •Google-most used
 - •AltaVista-most comprehensive
 - •Dogpile-a favorite for education

- Engines that search other engines
- Dogpile example
- one search returns results from many other search engines

Directory

(also called subject directories)

- Good starting point if you don't have a very specific topic or question
- · Good for general questions
- · very selective
- · index reviewed by human being
- smaller database coverage
- paid inclusion

Meta Site

(also called specialized directories or portals)

- Good starting point if you need info on a specific topic or question
- specialized
- · very selective
- immediate "expertise"
- · index reviewed by human being
- smaller database coverage
- paid inclusion

Pick a topic and a tool


- Choose between

 - Specialialty search engine




Internet Basics

Formulate a search question

- This may be given by the teacher
 - Make it a good question!
 - Research rather than report
 - open ended
- This may be chosen by the students
 - Help them ask a good question
 - Research rather than report
 - Workable









The Grammar of the Internet

How to read the URL

- (http://) is a protocol name
- · (www.) is the location of the site
- (gpsk12) This is the name of the organization that maintains the site
- (.com, .org, .gov, .net, .mil, .edu or state.us) domain or suffix that identifies the category of the organization



Keyword Searching

Define Keywords

- talk about what to enter into the search box
- talk about how kids/students search now
- ask about the types of things that they look up when they go online
- talk about entering full questions

- · formulate research questions
- practice
- · use games and make it fun!






